RESCINDED DIRECTIVE 10-2020 CATTARAUGUS COUNTY, NEW YORK

I, Howard V. VanRensselaer, Chairman, Cattaraugus County Legislature, in accordance with a declaration of a State of Emergency issued on March 15, 2020 and pursuant to Section 25 of the State Executive Law, hereby **rescind** the following directive:

Cattaraugus County COVID-19 Entry Screening at County Facilities

Purpose: To protect the safety and welfare of employees and visitors during the COVID-19 pandemic, members of the public will be screened for illness prior to entry into the County facilities located at 303 Court Street, Little Valley, New York; Cattaraugus-Little Valley School, Little Valley Campus, Rock City Street, Little Valley, New York; and One Leo Moss Drive, Olean, New York .


Process:

1. Personnel will be assigned to screen members of the public at the entry point of County facilities.
2. The Screener shall ask every person entering the building if the person has any of the following symptoms:
 - Fever - Either of the following:
 - $>100.0^{\circ}$ F at entry site or reported at home
 - Subjective fever/chills
 - Cough
 - Difficulty Breathing
 - Body Aches
 - Headache
 - Sore throat
 - Runny Nose
 - Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
3. **Individuals will not be allowed to enter if they have ANY of the above symptoms.**
4. The Screener shall take the temperature of those persons who do not disclose any of the above symptoms.
 - a. **If the temperature is $>100.0^{\circ}$ F, the person will be denied entry into the facility.**
5. Screeners do not need to wear any PPE, other than gloves if body contact is necessary when obtaining the temperature.
 - a. Temperature should be obtained with the Screener's arm fully extended out straight to maximize distance during screening.
 - b. Screener should perform hand hygiene after screening.


6. There shall be a "Mandatory Screening Required Prior to Entry" notice, which is attached hereto, posted at the point of entry of the Little Valley and Olean facilities.

This Directive is hereby rescinded effective May 19, 2021.





MANDATORY SCREENING REQUIRED Prior to Entry

If you have ANY of the following symptoms, you will not be allowed to enter the building:

- Fever:
 - $>100.0^{\circ}$ F here or at home
 - Subjective fever/chills
- Cough
- Difficulty Breathing
- Body Aches
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Runny Nose
- Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea

**RESCINDED DIRECTIVE 11-2020
CATTARAUGUS COUNTY, NEW YORK**

I, Howard V. VanRensselaer, Chairman, Cattaraugus County Legislature, in accordance with a declaration of a State of Emergency issued on March 15, 2020 and pursuant to Section 25 of the State Executive Law, hereby **rescind** the following directive:

To protect the safety and welfare of employees during the COVID-19 pandemic, all employees shall submit to a pre-shift temperature screening as follows:

1. All employees shall self-monitor and check his or her temperature every 12 hours whether at work or at home.
2. All employees shall also undergo a pre-shift temperature screening when reporting to work at the beginning of each shift.
3. All employees shall report at the beginning of each shift to a central designated point of entry which shall be determined by the County Administrator.
4. For employees that do not report to a physical building every day and instead travel from home to places in the community, each shall perform a pre-shift temperature screening before each shift. Leaving the home and reporting to your work site is the equivalent of your attestation that you are without a fever.

This Directive is hereby rescinded effective May 19, 2021.





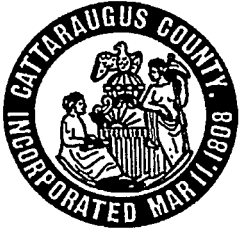

**RESCINDED DIRECTIVE 14-2020
CATTARAUGUS COUNTY, NEW YORK**

I, Howard V. VanRensselaer, Chairman, Cattaraugus County Legislature, in accordance with a declaration of a State of Emergency issued on March 15, 2020, and subsequent extensions thereto, and pursuant to Section 25 of the State Executive Law, hereby **rescind** the following directive:

Effective April 17, 2020, at 8 p.m., the Governor directed pursuant to Executive Order 202.17 that anyone “who is over the age of two and able to medically tolerate a face-covering shall be required to cover their nose and mouth with a mask or cloth face-covering when in public and unable to maintain or when not maintaining, social distance.”

Pursuant to Executive Order 202.17, and for the safety and welfare of the general public and county employees, all individuals wishing to enter the County facilities located at 303 Court Street, Little Valley, New York; Cattaraugus-Little Valley School, Little Valley Campus, Rock City Street, Little Valley, New York; and One Leo Moss Drive, Olean, New York, must wear a mask or face-covering upon entry.

This Directive is hereby rescinded effective May 19, 2021.
