**AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR TO EXECUTE AMENDED CONTRACT WITH
CLEAN HARBORS ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, INC. FOR
HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE PROGRAM
(Fuel Surcharge)**

Pursuant to Sections 226-b and 450 of the County Law.

I. WHEREAS, Act 237-2019 authorized a contract with Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc., for the collection, transportation and disposal of household hazardous waste for Cattaraugus County residents, the term of which expires May 31, 2021, with an option to renew for one (1) additional one (1) year period at the same rates, and

II. WHEREAS, due to rising gas prices, Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc., has requested a maximum fuel surcharge of 8.5% for the October 2021 household hazardous waste collection, and

III. WHEREAS, a contract amendment is needed in order to approve such fuel surcharge, and

IV. WHEREAS, sufficient funds are included in the budget to cover the costs of the aforementioned surcharge, now, therefore, be it

I. RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Legislature be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute an amended contract, on behalf of Cattaraugus County, with Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc., for the payment of a maximum fuel surcharge of 8.5% during the October 2021 household hazardous waste collection, and to amend the original contract which commenced June 1, 2019 and now terminates May 31, 2022, according to the above-described terms.

I. WHEREAS, Act 464-2019 authorized a contract with Dataval, Inc., 201 West Genesee Street, PMB 273, Fayetteville, New York 13066, for the provision of water monitoring data validation services for the Farwell (Town of Ischua) and Five Points (Town of Mansfield) Landfills, the term of which expires December 31, 2021, with the County's sole option to renew for two (2) additional one-year periods at the same rates, terms and conditions, and

II. WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has modified the sampling schedules, and

III. WHEREAS, due to such sampling schedule modification, the County Department of Public Works is also desirous of modifying the water monitoring data validation services, and

I. WHEREAS, Act 618-2019 authorized the Chairman to execute grant documents with the New York State Occupational Safety and Health Hazard Abatement Board for the 2019-2020 Occupational Safety and Health Training and Education Grant program, and

II. WHEREAS, the County has been awarded an amount of \$3,525.00 through the aforementioned grant for the 2020-2021 program year, and

III. WHEREAS, a contract with the New York State Occupational Safety and Health Hazard Abatement Board is necessary in order to receive the aforementioned grant, now, therefore, be it

I. II. WHEREAS, the City of Olean is allowing the County to dump leachate material generated from the Farwell Landfill into the City's waste water treatment facility for an amount of \$.0113 per gallon of leachate waste disposed of by the County, and

III. WHEREAS, the City is requesting additional fees for the disposal of leachate during off hours, as follows:

During off hours from 3pm to 7am \$150.00 per call for up to 2 hours
\$50.00 per hour for each additional hour,

and

IV. WHEREAS, the County Department of Public Works has agreed to pay the aforementioned fees in the event that leachate disposal services are necessary during off hours, and

V. WHEREAS, sufficient funds are included in the budget to cover the costs for the aforementioned services, now, therefore, be it

I. RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Legislature be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute an amended contract, on behalf of Cattaraugus County, with the City of Olean, for the provision of the above-described disposal services during off hours, to amend the original contract which commenced June 1, 2018 and continues in full force and effect until terminated by either party hereto, according to the above-described terms.

I.
