**AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR TO EXECUTE SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. 1 WITH
NYS DOT AND AUTHORIZING CATTARAUGUS COUNTY TO PARTICIPATE IN
THE FEDERAL-AID PROJECT ADMINISTERED BY THE NYS DOT AND
ADJUSTING VARIOUS APPROPRIATION AND REVENUE ACCOUNTS
(Leon Bridge No. 40 Replacement Project – Bridge NY Funds Contract #D036252)**

Pursuant to Title 23 U.S. Code and Sections 363, 366 and 450 of the County Law.

- I. WHEREAS, Act 142-2019 authorized a project for the replacement of Leon Bridge No. 40 (BIN 3-3222-90), located on Dredge Road over Conewango Creek in the Town of Leon, Cattaraugus County, PIN 5762.95, Comptroller's Contract #D036252 (the "Project"), and is eligible for reimbursement of qualified costs from Bridge NY funding that calls for the post-reimbursement apportionment of the qualified costs to be borne at the ratio of 95% Bridge NY funds and 5% local funds, and
 - II. WHEREAS, the County will design, let and administer all phases of the Project, and
 - III. WHEREAS, the County desires to advance the above Project by making a commitment of 100% of the costs of the Preliminary Engineering (Design I-VI), Right-of-Way Incidentals and Construction/Construction Inspection phases of the Project, PIN 5762.95, and
 - IV. WHEREAS, various appropriation and revenue accounts must be adjusted in order to cover the costs of the aforementioned project, now, therefore, be it
- I. RESOLVED, that the Cattaraugus County Legislature hereby approves the above-described Project, and be it further
 - II. RESOLVED, that the Cattaraugus County Legislature hereby authorizes the County of Cattaraugus to pay 100% of the cost of the Preliminary Engineering (Design I-VI), Right-of-Way Incidentals and Construction/Construction Inspection phases of the Project, or portions thereof, with the understanding that qualified costs will be reimbursed from Bridge NY funding, and be it further
 - III. RESOLVED, that the sum of \$1,559,580.00 is hereby appropriated, in addition to \$286,000.00 previously appropriated for the Project's Preliminary Engineering (Design I-VI) and Right-of-Way Incidentals phases via County Resolution No. 142-2019 adopted on March 27, 2019, and made available to cover the cost of participation in the Preliminary Engineering (Design I-VI), Right-of-Way Incidentals and Construction/Construction Inspection phases of the Project, and be it further
 - IV. RESOLVED, that the Cattaraugus County Legislature hereby agrees that the County of Cattaraugus shall be responsible for all costs of the project which exceed the amount of reimbursement available from the Bridge NY funding awarded to the County of Cattaraugus, and be it further
 - V. RESOLVED, that in the event the costs of the Project exceed the total amount appropriated above (\$1,845,580.00), the County of Cattaraugus shall convene its Legislature as soon as possible to appropriate said excess amount immediately upon the notification by the NYS DOT thereof, and be it further
 - VI. RESOLVED, that the County of Cattaraugus hereby commits that construction of the Project shall begin no later than eighteen (18) months after award and that the construction phase of the Project shall be completed within three (3) years of commencing construction, and be it further

VII. RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Legislature be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute all necessary documents, certifications or reimbursement requests with the NYSDOT for State Aid and/or Bridge NY funding, on behalf of Cattaraugus County, in connection with the advancement or approval of the Project and providing for the administration of the Project and the municipality's funding of the Project costs, and be it further

VIII. RESOLVED, that the County of Cattaraugus will be responsible for all maintenance of the Project, and be it further

IX. RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this resolution be filed with the New York State Commissioner of Transportation by attaching it to any necessary agreement in connection with the Project, and be it further

X. RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately, and be it further

WHEREAS, Act 234-2021 authorized a contract with Be-A-Friend Program, Inc., Big Brothers Big Sisters of Erie, Niagara and the Southern Tier, 100 River Rock Drive, Suite 104, Buffalo, New York 14207, for the provision of a group mentoring program to youths between the ages of 10 to 15 to promote academic and community success for youth considered PINS, JD, JO or AO through job readiness, independent living skills, youth advocacy and leadership development, the term of which expires May 31, 2022, and

II. WHEREAS, the County Department of Social Services is desirous of continuing the aforementioned mentoring program, and

III. WHEREAS, Be-A-Friend Program, Inc., Big Brothers Big Sisters of Erie, Niagara and the Southern Tier, can provide a group mentoring program to promote academic and community success for youth for a total contract amount not to exceed \$35,000.00 to be paid on a monthly basis for services provided during the preceding month, as invoiced, and

III. WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Health has authorized an amount of \$34,805.00 per year for a three-year total of \$104,415.00, for the period running April 1, 2022 through March 31, 2025, and

IV. WHEREAS, the Cattaraugus County Health Department is desirous of contracting with the New York State Department of Health in order to receive the aforementioned funding, and

V. WHEREAS, the rabies program is 100% state funded, now, therefore, be it

I. RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Legislature be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute a contract, on behalf of Cattaraugus County, with the New York State Department of Health, in order to receive the aforementioned rabies reimbursement, for a term commencing April 1, 2022 and terminating March 31, 2025, according to the above-described terms, and be it further

- IV. WHEREAS, these programs are 100% state funded, now, therefore, be it
- I. RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Legislature be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute such contracts, applications and other documents, on behalf of Cattaraugus County, as deemed necessary to effect the establishment of the various youth programs in 2022, and be it further
- II. RESOLVED, that prior to entering into any contract for youth programs for 2022, such programs shall be approved, in writing, by the Cattaraugus County Youth Bureau Board of Directors, and be it further
- III. RESOLVED, that any such contracts, applications, or other documents are further contingent upon subsequent approval by the New York State Office of Children & Family Services of the program and program budgeting and are null and void until and unless such approval is obtained, and be it further
- IV. RESOLVED, that the County's participation in any of the various programs will be to reimburse the sponsoring agency 100% for reimbursable expenditures as defined under the New York State Office of Children & Family Services Guidelines and approved by the Cattaraugus County Youth Bureau with reimbursement set forth infra, and be it further
- V. RESOLVED, that all reimbursement to the sponsoring agency by the County of Cattaraugus up to the maximum of the approved program cost for fiscal year 2022 will take effect after the sponsoring agency has filed appropriate state aid forms with the Cattaraugus County Youth Bureau, and the Youth Bureau has approved those forms, and be it further
- VI. RESOLVED, that any such contract entered into between the County and a sponsoring agency shall provide, inter alia, a provision that, in the event the State of New York fails to reimburse the County as contractually outlined, the sponsoring agency shall reimburse the County for the total amount of funds provided by the County pursuant hereto, and be it further
- VII. RESOLVED, that upon termination of either state or federal funding for this program, then this program shall be automatically abolished, and be it further
- VIII. RESOLVED, that such contract shall provide that upon the reduction of any such funding, the County, in its sole discretion, may terminate the contract on thirty (30) days' written notice, and be it further

IX. RESOLVED, that in the event of any such reduction, the department head involved shall immediately report such occurrence to the Chairman of the Committee to which the department is assigned, who shall add the matter to the agenda of the Committee's next meeting.
