## AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR TO APPLY FOR FUNDING THROUGH U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL FUNDING

Pursuant to Section 450 of the County Law.

I. WHEREAS, federal funding is available through the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) for the fiscal year 2023 Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Funding, and WHEREAS, the purpose of the aforementioned grant is to improve roadway safety by significantly reducing or eliminating roadway fatalities and serious injuries through safety action plan development and refinement and implementation focused on all users, including pedestrians, bicyclists, public transportation users, motorists, personal conveyance and micromobility users, and commercial vehicle operators, and III. WHEREAS, the County Department of Public Works is desirous of applying for the aforementioned planning grant funding to develop a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan, and IV. WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Safety Action Plan will identify safety improvements, programs and strategies to reduce by 50% the number of fatal crashes and serious injury crashes by 2050 with an eventual goal of eliminating roadway fatalities and serious injuries, and V. WHEREAS, this grant is 80% federally funded (CFDA #20.939) and 20% County match, now, therefore, be it I. RESOLVED, that the Cattaraugus County Legislature concurs and supports the goals identified as part of the 2023 Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grant application, and be it further II. RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Legislature be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute a grant application, on behalf of Cattaraugus County, with the U.S. Department of Transportation, in order to apply for the USDOT Safe Streets and Roads for All funding, according to the above-described terms, and be it further III. RESOLVED, that upon termination of either state or federal funding for this program, then this program shall be automatically abolished, and be it further IV. RESOLVED, that such contract shall provide that upon the reduction of any such funding, the County, in its sole discretion, may terminate the contract on thirty (30) days' written notice, and be it

WHEREAS, the West Valley Central School District is desirous of participating in the School ١. Resource Officer ("SRO") Program by having a school resource officer placed in its facility, and WHEREAS, the SRO Program is designed to provide education, law enforcement and II. counseling to high school students and to encourage youths not to abuse drugs or alcohol, and to promote living a safe, law abiding, successful life, and III. WHEREAS, the Cattaraugus County Sheriff's Office has agreed to assign a law enforcement officer to the West Valley Central School District at no cost to the County, and IV. WHEREAS, the West Valley Central School District has agreed to pay to the Sheriff's Office the actual cost of one (1) full-time school resource officer, which shall include all wages and fringe benefits, and the costs associated with training and uniforms, and ٧. WHEREAS, the West Valley Central School District shall provide a vehicle for SRO-related business and shall be responsible for all operational costs related to such vehicle, the use of which will be devoted to SRO-related business under the contract hereby authorized, including, but not limited to, tires, maintenance, fuel and repairs, and VI. WHEREAS, sufficient funds are included in the budget various appropriation and revenue accounts must be adjusted to cover the aforementioned costs, now, therefore, be it I. RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Legislature be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute a contract, on behalf of Cattaraugus County, with the West Valley Central School District, for participation in the School Resource Officer Program, for a term commencing July 1, 2023 and terminating June 30, 2024, with the option to renew for successive one-year terms under the same terms and conditions, according to the above-described terms, and be it further II. # AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR TO EXECUTE AMENDED CONTRACT WITH PIONEER CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER PROGRAM AND ADJUSTING VARIOUS APPROPRIATION AND REVENUE ACCOUNTS (Sheriff's Office)

Pursuant to Sections 363, 366 and 450 of the County Law.

- I. WHEREAS, Act 242-2017, as amended by Act 345-2022, authorized a contract with the Pioneer Central School District ("District") for participation in the School Resource Officer ("SRO") Program by placing two (2) full-time and one (1) part-time school resource officers in its District, and
- II. WHEREAS, the Pioneer Central School District has requested a third full-time school resource officer to be assigned effective July 1, 2023, and
- III. WHEREAS, the Cattaraugus County Sheriff's Office has agreed to assign law enforcement officers to the District at no cost to the County, and
- IV. WHEREAS, the District has agreed to pay to the Sheriff's Office the actual cost of three (3) full-time and one (1) part-time school resource officers, which shall include all wages and fringe benefits, and the costs associated with training, uniforms and cellular phones, and
- V. WHEREAS, the District shall be responsible for the initial purchase of any SRO vehicles and all of the operational costs associated with the SRO vehicles, including, but not limited to, tires, maintenance, fuel and repairs, and
- VI. WHEREAS, during the period of the County's ownership of the vehicles, the Sheriff may equip, paint and otherwise mark the vehicle, and convey ownership of the vehicles back to the District as soon as practicable following termination of the agreement, and
- VII. WHEREAS, upon the termination of the agreement, the Sheriff shall remove all such markings on the vehicles prior to its return to the District, and
- VIII. WHEREAS, sufficient funds are included in the budget various appropriation and revenue accounts must be adjusted to cover the cost of the SRO Program, now, therefore, be it
- I. RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Legislature be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute an amended contract, on behalf of Cattaraugus County, with the Pioneer Central School District, for the provision of the School Resource Officer Program, for a term commencing July 1, 2023 and terminating June 30, 2024, with the option to renew for successive one-year terms under the same terms and conditions, according to the above-described terms, and be it further
- II. RESOLVED, that upon termination of either state or federal funding for this program, then this program shall be automatically abolished, and be it further

- III. RESOLVED, that such contract shall provide that upon the reduction of any such funding, the County, in its sole discretion, may terminate the contract on thirty (30) days written notice, and be it further
- IV. RESOLVED, that in the event of any such reduction, the department head involved shall immediately report such occurrence to the Chairman of the Committee to which the department is assigned, who shall add the matter to the agenda of the Committee's next meeting, *and be it further*
