- V. WHEREAS, the employer of record for the Fellows is Staffing Solutions Organization, who will retain Fellows under its payroll and provide all applicable benefits to staff under the Public Health Corps Fellowship Program, and
- VI. WHEREAS, the Health Department must execute a Letter of Intent to indicate the County's participation in the Public Health Corps Fellowship Program, now, therefore, be it
