Pursuant to Sections 363, 366 and 450 of the County Law.

WHEREAS, Act 73-2014 authorized the adoption of the Cattaraugus County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard I. Mitigation Plan, and II. WHEREAS, FEMA has approved funding for the Pre-Disaster Mitigation Competitive (PDMC) sub grant application PDMC-PL-02-NY-2017-018 under which the County would commence the process of updating the Cattaraugus County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, and WHEREAS, the County has been awarded funding in the amount of \$150,000.00, with a federal share of \$112,500.00 and a required 25% non-federal matching share of \$37,500.00, for the PDMC-PL-02-NY-2017-018, for an updated multi-jurisdictional mitigation plan, and IV. WHEREAS, a contract is necessary with FEMA, United States Department of Homeland Security Region II, in order to obtain the aforementioned funding, and ٧.
